


Figure A1: Rules (each concrete one) vs. Level of permissiveness (raw sum). Size is proportional to the number of observations within each permissiveness level.






Figure A3: Time series of the outcome variable, difference in rules.




Figure A4: Correlation matrix between explanatory variables for the main reference model. Model w/o interactions.





Figure A5: Correlation matrix between rule adoption.






